- The Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, will address the **125th anniversary** celebration 'Prabuddha Bharata' which is scheduled to be organized on January 31, 2021

- The Larsen & Toubro (L&T) has bagged a contract worth Rs 1390 crore for the Mumbai-Ahmedabad bullet train project. This project is India's first such project. L&T has bagged the contract for the project from the National High-Speed Rail Corporation Limited (NHSRCL).
- President Ram Nath Kovind on January 30, 2021 launched the countrywide Pulse Polio Programme for 2021 by administering polio drops to children less than five years old at the Rashtrapati Bhawan. **The Polio National Immunization Day** (NID), also known as the "Polio Ravivar", will be observed on January 31.
- The **73rd death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi** was observed as Martyrs' Day on January 30, 2021. He was assassinated on this day in 1948.
- In Kargil Ladakh, the **first ever Zanskar Winter Sports and Youth Festival**, **2021 concluded at Munskit Chumik Zanskar** on January 30, 2021. The Festival featured various cultural and sports activities like ice hockey, snow skiing, horse riding, yak riding, ice climbing, snow sculpture, archery matches.

• Madhya Pradesh has launched a new scheme **PANKH Abhiyan**. The letter **PANKH** stands for Protection, Awareness of their Rights Nutrition Knowledge and Health

- Uttar Pradesh will launch a state-wide, free coaching programme named 'Abhyudaya' from February. This coaching programme will help students to prepare for various competitive examinations.
- The **first commercial flight services between Delhi and Sikkim commenced on January 23, 2021** with a Bombardier Q400 aircraft of SpiceJet airline. The flight landed at Pakyong airport in the Himalayan state with 57 passengers.
- Spain and France have recently signed an agreement to build 590 MW of solar power plant. This will be the largest solar power plant in Europe
- The **Operation Sard Hawa was launched by the Border Security Force** in the western border of Rajasthan. The main purpose of the operation is to check the instances of infiltration due to dense fog in the region. The Operation has also been launched to enhance the security ahead of Republic Day

- **Britain abolished** the so-called "**tampon tax**" on 1st January 2021, eliminating sales taxes on women's sanitary products.
- The **World Health Organization** says it has **cleared** the **Pfizer-BioNTech** coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccine for emergency use.
- The CBI has booked Delhi-based **Shakti Bhog Foods Limited** and others for allegedly **cheating a consortium of 10 banks to the tune of ₹3,269.42 crore**.
- A **fly ash rake** from Simhadri Super Thermal Power Plant (NTPC), Visakhapatnam, was transported for the first time by the Waltair Division of East Coast Railway (ECoR).
- **TiHAN-IIT Testbed** for autonomous navigation systems has been set up at IIT-**Hyderabad**. It is India's first Testbed for Autonomous Navigation System. **TiHAN stands for Technology Innovation Hub on Autonomous Navigation Systems**.
- The Ministry of Defence recently signed an agreement with the Bharat Electronics Limited to supply **ten LYNX U2 GFCS**. It is a **Naval Gun Fire Control System**. It has been designed to track and engage targets amidst sea clutter. It can accurately track air and surface targets. Also, it can generate required target data to predict weapon aiming points. The target engagement is done using Russian A190, AK176 and AK630.
- The headquarter of **International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO)** which is recently in news is located in **Madrid, Spain**.
